

How to interpret your HSLDA Online Academy Spanish Placement results

- 1. There are 250 possible points:
 - A score of 200 or higher means you are well-qualified for HSLDA Spanish 2.
 - A score of 199-150 means you might be ready for HSLDA Spanish 2 (see #2 below).
 - A score of 149 or less means you should take HSLDA Spanish 1.
- 2. If your score was between 199-150, consider these other factors:
 - o Did you grow up in a Spanish-speaking environment?
 - Did you study Spanish in a formal program within the last year?
 - o Are you strong in English and in Math?
 - If you answered "yes" to **TWO** or **THREE** of the above questions, then you are <u>likely</u> prepared enough for Spanish 2, <u>but</u>:
 - You should spend 5-10 hours reviewing Spanish on <u>www.duolingo.com</u> immediately before starting Spanish 2; and,
 - You should be prepared to struggle at times in Spanish 2, and,
 - You should be in regular contact with your teacher about your progress.
- → In the end, the choice is yours as to Spanish 1 or Spanish 2. Because we do not want students to be over-placed in a course it will be better for you to take Spanish 1 than Spanish 2 if you are unsure.
